

## Instructions & Guidelines for Poster Presentation

Posters can be on display during the whole conference starting from 9:00 AM Monday (July 14) up to 4:30 PM Wednesday (July 16).

Maximum space for each poster is 36 inches (~90 cm) wide by 36 inches (~90 cm) high. Posters can be one or multiple pieces. Each author is responsible for assembly and removal of his/her presentation. Posters should show the names and affiliations of all contributing authors. From 10 feet away the viewer should see an easy-to-read title and an uncluttered, neat arrangement of photos and/or illustrations and text. Different font size and styles can be used.

### Poster Competition

Poster Competition is organized at GSB Conference to encourage researchers to present their original / high impact work. This competition is open to all poster presenters. The judges will come to your poster during poster presentations, which will take place on Monday (July 14) and Tuesday (July 15) afternoons from 3:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Criteria for poster judgement are as follow:

- Clarity of presentation
- Abstract is presented in an unbiased manner
- Background provides appropriate perspective/context for the subject
- Objectives/research questions are clearly stated
- Research design, methods and modelling are appropriate and transparent
- Data analyses are appropriate
- Research objectives are met/addressed

At the end of the conference 3 prizes will be awarded to the best poster presentations.

There will be prizes for one winner and two runner-ups (Winner: 400 AUD; Runner ups: 250 AUD each).
